Sending a Camper Mail: Camp Goodtimes

Every camper loves to hear, "You've got mail." Absolutely feel free to send your campers mail and packages. We have a team that will be on mail duty each day. You have a couple of options:

1. **Bring mail/packages with you to camp:** save money on shipping by simply bringing letters or packages with you to camper check in. We'll take them from you and store for safe keeping until they are delivered. Ensure the camper's name, and ideally their cabin number, is clearly written on the outside. Want a certain item to be delivered on a certain day? Simply write that delivery date on the outside.
2. **Mail letters or packages direct to camp:** you can mail letters/packages with USPS, FedEx, or UPS direct to campers if you use the address information below. Be sure that you plan your timing so that the letter/package doesn't arrive after the camper has left camp.

3. **Send a note via email:** have a short message you want to send to your kiddo? You can send an email message to the camp director's email address for delivery while at camp—tanya@thegoodtimesproject.org. Be sure to include the camper's first and last name, and cabin number if you know it, in the subject line and they will be printed and delivered.

Want campers to send mail home to you? We also send outgoing mail each day. The following are some suggestions for how best to facilitate getting your camper's letter into your hands.

- Send pre-addressed envelopes to camp with your child. Putting a stamp on it would be great too!
- Supply cards or stationery for them to write on. We can supply blank paper, but they may be more inclined to write if the materials are already there for them.
- If a child wants to write a note home and does not have stationery or an envelope, we will provide them. We can also look up addresses of a parent/guardian from the camper's application if they do not know their home address.
